TOUR AVAILABLE TO START ON WEDNESDAY ONLY

Day 1 (Wed)- ARRIVE IN CHIHUAHUA CITY

Chihuahua City is the capital of Chihuahua state, the largest state in Mexico. It is the passenger service terminus for the Chihuahua al Pacífico Railroad. This large, clean, high-desert city has museums and art galleries worth visiting. Revolutionary history abounds here. Your airport transport will give you your departure schedule for the train station tomorrow.

Day 2(Thu)- TRAIN JOURNEY TO DIVISADERO AREA

Your 7½-hour train journey today takes you into the Sierra Madre Mountains. Be sure to have your railroad log in your packet available on the train. You are riding the world-famous Chihuahua al Pacífico Railroad. This engineering masterpiece took about 90 years to complete and 90 million dollars. The engineers had to plan for 87 tunnels and 39 bridges to complete the line. You may have breakfast and lunch on the train. The dining car has been remodeled and the food is excellent. Your destination is the beautiful Mirador Hotel right on the rim of Copper Canyon – the most scenic location in all the canyon system. You need to get off at the Posada Barrancas train stop for the hotel. The hotel bus meets you. The view alone from your balcony will be worth the whole trip to you. This hotel has a wonderful, relaxing atmosphere and it is very conducive to contemplating the natural wonders around you.

Day 3(Fri) – MORNING TOUR TO DIVISADERO OVERLOOK & ADVENTURE PARK/ AFTERNOON TRASFER TO CEROCAHUI.

A morning tour to scenic overlooks is included this morning. An optional cable car ride across the canyon. is available (\$25 p/p). Optional Zip Lining is available too. (\$60 per person) Ask at front desk. The Tarahumara Indians may come in this morning and do some sample racing and dancing for you. Ttransfer by land to Cerocahui. Picturesque Hotel Misión helps you feel you are "away from it all" as you relax in the restful Spanish courtyard and admire the gold dome of the nearby 1556 mission church. You have time this afternoon to wander into the churchyard or stroll through the village to the cemetery and lumberyard or visit the Indian boarding school, next door to the hotel. You may run a bar tab here.

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Day 4(Sat)- MORNING TOUR TO URIQU OVERLOOK / AFTERNOON TRAIN JOURNE TO EL FUERTE

A world-class view awaits you today at the top of Urique Canyon. Your bus tour to this deepest canyon overlook in the system provides the most expansive photo opportunities on the trip. You will return to your train stop around 2:30pm. Your arrival in El Fuerte will be around 8:30 pm. You go from 7500 elevation to almost sea level. A Shuttle from the hotel will meet you at the train station to transfer you to your hotel.

Day 5(Sun)- DEPART EL FUERTE.
