**ITINERARY:** Trip DEPARTS and ends in Phoenix, AZ. #### 06:45 AM DEPARTURE: PHOENIX, AZ to SAN CARLOS, SONORA

After breakfast depart from at 6:45 AM through the international border of Nogales. Ride through the Sonoran Desert to the Sea of Cortez arriving to the beautiful seaside city of San Carlos in the state of Sonora, a beachfront subdivision in the city of Guaymas, known for the clarity and warmth of the ocean water in its shallow bays.

#### PEARL FARM IN GUAYMAS.

#### SAN CARLOS, SONORA TO EL FUERTE, SINALOA

After breakfast at HOTEL depart from San Carlos at 8:00 AM for travel to El Fuerte in the state of Sinaloa. En route visit a pearl farm known as the "Perlas del Mar de Cortez" (Pearls of the Sea of Cortez). The pearl farm is situated in the Sea of Cortez, which is famous for its clear waters and rich marine life. Learn about the process of pearl cultivation, the types of pearls produced, and the history of pearl diving in the region. Continue the route. Submerge in scenic views and stops along the way for lunch, breaks and shopping.

Estimated time of arrival in El Fuerte is 5:00 PM. Gather at the pool area for a lively presentation of the legendary vigilante El Zorro; before dinner at Hotel Posada Hidalgo. At Hotel Posada Hidalgo, the legend of Zorro is celebrated as part of the hotel's charm and history. The hotel itself is located in a historic building that dates back to the 19th century, and it is often associated with the rich cultural heritage of the region, including stories of bandits, heroes, and legendary figures like Zorro.

#### RIDE THE CHEPE EXPRESS TRAIN CHEPE EXPRESS

#### WINE TASTING EXPERIENCE FROM HOTEL MISION VINEYARDS

After breakfast at Hotel Posada Hidalgo, depart from El Fuerte at 8:15 AM to El Fuerte Train Station. Board the Chihuahua al Pacifico Railroad train on a 5-hour ride through the Copper Canyon on the famous El Chepe. As the train departs El Fuerte, it starts to wind through lush valleys and rolling hills. The landscapes change dramatically as you move away from the town, with views of fertile farmland, rivers, and mountains in the distance. The train journey takes you through a variety of terrains, including dense forests, open fields, and rugged mountain areas. As you approach the Sierra Tarahumara, the scenery becomes increasingly dramatic, with steep cliffs and deep canyons coming into view. One of the highlights of this journey is the breathtaking views of the surrounding canyons. The train often runs parallel to the stunning cliffs and ravines, providing ample opportunities to take in the majestic beauty of the Copper Canyon region. Keep an eye out for wildlife along the route.

**TRAIN SCHEDULE:** Depart El Fuerte 09:20AM. Arrive Bahuichivo TS 2:25PM

Train station stop is Bahuichivo. Depart from El Chepe and board a van for a short ride to the Valley of Cerocahui to Hotel Mision, located in the beautiful Cerocahui, a small village nestled in the heart of the Sierra Tarahumara. The hotel offers stunning views and connection to the surrounding natural beauty, and serene environment. Choices for sightseeing will be presented to travelers, included, but not limited to a boarding school for Tarahumara girls and Mission Church. Before dinner, enjoy an exquisite Balderrama wine tasting experience, enhanced by the vineyard inside the hotel.

**URIQUE CANYON OVERLOOK (CERRO GALLEGO)**

**VAN TRANSFER TO DIVISADERO, CHIHUAHUA (COPPER CANYON RIM)**

After breakfast at Hotel Mision, depart at 8:00 AM to Urique Canyon Overlook (7,000 ft); the deepest and most expansive view of the canyon on this itinerary. The Urique Canyon Overlook provides a stunning panoramic view of one of nature's most impressive landscapes. The combination of dramatic cliffs, vibrant colors, lush vegetation, and the winding river creates a breathtaking experience that captures the essence of the Copper Canyon region.

Return to Hotel Mision before noon for check out; continue by land (1hr) to the rim of the Copper Canyon and Hotel Mirador on the Rim. You are right on the rim of Copper Canyon – the most scenic location in all the canyon system. This hotel has a wonderful, relaxing atmosphere and it is very conducive to contemplating the natural wonders around you. From the comfort of your room's balcony, you will feel surrounded by the lush beauty of the Copper Canyons and its dramatic canyon landscape.

**COPPER CANYON ADVENTURE PARK (DIVISADERO AREA)**

After breakfast at Hotel Mirador, depart at 9:00 AM to Copper Canyon Adventure Park. Travelers will experience different canyon views from Divisadero. Optimal activities at the park are offered at additional cost, i.e.; Ziplining, cable car, rock among other events. In this place of privileged beauty, we recommend a walk around the edge of the canyon to enjoy the majestic views.

**SUNDAY (BT) / (TT)**

**TRAIN CHEPE EXPRESS: DIVISADERO TO EL FUERTE, SINALOA**

After breakfast at Hotel Mirador, depart at 9:00 AM for Divisadero Train Station. Board El Chepe for a 7½-hour journey aboard this marvelous engineering feat through the Sierra Madre Mountains, descending from 8,000 feet to sea level. The route takes you through pine forests, rocky cliffs, and open valleys. You'll witness the transition from the high-altitude terrain of the canyon rim to the lower elevations as you approach El Fuerte. Keep an eye out for wildlife along the way.

**TRAIN SCHEDULE:** Depart Divisadero Train Station at 09:55 AM. Arrive at El Fuerte Train Station at 3:35 PM

Travelers will disembark at El Fuerte Train Station. Founded in the 16th century, El Fuerte has a rich history that dates back to the Spanish colonial period. The town's name, which means "The Fort," refers to the fort established by the Spanish to protect against attacks from indigenous groups. Dinner will be at Hotel Posada Hidalgo.

Traveling from San Carlos, Sonora, Mexico, to Phoenix, Arizona, involves a scenic route that takes you through a mix of beautiful landscapes and border crossings. At the Nogales border crossing, you will go through customs and immigration. Make sure to your passport ready. The entire journey typically takes around 4 to 5 hours, not including time spent at the border crossing or any stops along the way. Expected arrival is between 5:00 – 8:00 PM. \*Drop off available at Green Valley and Tucson. END OF SERVICES.

**OBSERVATIONS:**

- \*Minimum of 08 passengers required to confirm tour departure date.
- \*Transportation varies based on # of travelers: van/sprinter, mini-coach, or motorcoach.
- \*Groups depart to Mexico from Phoenix on Saturday and return/cross the border to Phoenix on Sunday.
- \*Registration: A completed registration/agreement form will be required to reserve your seat on the tour.
- \*Passport with at least 6-month expiration required.
- \*This tour is suitable for people in good health, i.e., walk on rocky paths at high altitudes (up to 7800ft elevations), balance aboard moving train, and extensive bus/van rides.
- \*Most rooms have 2 double beds. We will try to accommodate your preferred bed configuration.

**TOUR NOTES:**

- ❖ **Activity Level:** Copper Canyon region in Mexico reaches at an altitude of 8,600 ft. You need to be in good health. Moderate activity required, including walks, stairs and uneven walkways, sidewalks and cobblestone streets are common. Walking tours are arranged where vehicle transportation is impossible. Seeing everything mentioned in this itinerary requires active participation. There can be longer walks at the train station or overlooks. If you feel you are not able to keep up with the group or require assistance, we recommend that you bring a capable companion to assist you. The guide, tour director, and driver have many responsibilities, so please do not expect them or your fellow travelers to provide ongoing assistance. Please be mindful of your fellow travelers.
- ❖ **Guide:** A bilingual (English/Spanish) Mexican guide accompanies you on all the days in Mexico. The Mexican guide provides commentary and knowledge about the culture and history.
- ❖ **Accommodations:** Our hotel stays will be in unique and historic buildings with great location and distinct locations. Due to the remoteness of the area HOTELS do not have elevators. Hotel Posada Hidalgo requires a walk up a steep ramp. Hotel Mirador may require a 3-4 story walk. Hotels named in the itinerary are subject to change but will be of similar characteristics.
- ❖ **Documentation:** A passport with at least six-month expiration is required.
- ❖ **Tour Changes:** The itinerary as stated for each tour must be taken only as an indication of what each group may accomplish and not a contractual obligation.
