DAY 1 – **SUN/WED/FRI - (VT) / (TT) **LOS MOCHIS (LMM) – EL FUERTE, SINALOA****

Complimentary transfer from Los Mochis to the El Fuerte. El Fuerte is one of four (4) Magical Towns (Pueblo Mágicos) in the State of Sinaloa and is situated on the Chepe train line, just 1½ hours from Los Mochis. Your overnight is in Posada Hidalgo – a restored sprawling hacienda of a former mayor with a beautiful courtyard full of tropical vegetation, and a swimming pool. It is well known for its superb cuisine. Overnight at Posada Hidalgo.

DAY 2 – **MON/ THUR/SAT- (VT) / (TT) **EL FUERTE SINALOA / CEROCAHUI, CHIHUAHUA****

Breakfast at Posada Hidalgo. Check out and gather at the lobby at 08:15 am for a 20-minute van ride to El Fuerte Train Station. All aboard the Chihuahua al Pacífico train on a 4 ½ hour ride through the Copper Canyon on the famous El Chepe. Journey the Sierra Madre Mountains ascending from sea level to over 5,500 ft. This engineering masterpiece took about 90 years and 90 million dollars to complete. The engineers had to plan for 87 tunnels and 39 bridges to complete the line.

TRAIN SCHEDULE: Depart El Fuerte Train Station at 9:20am. Arrive Bahuichivo Train Station at 2:25pm.

Travelers will disembark at Bahuichivo Train Station for a short 25-minute van ride to the beautiful valley of Cerocahui to picturesque Hotel Mision. Relax in the restful Spanish courtyard and admire the gold dome of the nearby 1556 mission church. You have time this afternoon to wander into the churchyard or stroll through the village to the cemetery and lumberyard or visit the Tarahumara boarding school, next door to the hotel and for a 4-mile roundtrip walk to the Cerocahui waterfall. Overnight Hotel Mision.

DAY 3 – **TUE/FRI/SUN - (VT) / (TT) **CEROCAHUI to DIVISADERO (COPPER CANYON), CHIHUAHUA****

Breakfast at Hotel Mision. Tour to the deepest canyon overlooks in the system provides the most expansive canyon views on this trip (8am – 11am). Check out at 11:30am. Travel Copper Canyon (Divisadero) by van for an hour. This stop is a must! It offers one of the most spectacular natural wonders in Mexico and the world. Three canyons are found here: Urique, Tararecua and Cobre.

You are scheduled to arrive at the beautiful Mirador Hotel at 12:30pm. You are right on the rim of Copper Canyon – the most scenic location in all the canyon system. This hotel has a wonderful, relaxing atmosphere and it is very conducive to contemplating the natural wonders around you. From the comfort of your room’s balcony, you will feel surrounded by the lush beauty of the Copper Canyons. In this place of privileged beauty, we recommend a walk around the edge of the canyon to enjoy the majestic views. Afternoon tour is to Divisadero Overlook and Barrancas del Cobre (Copper Canyon) Adventure Park (included). Overnight Hotel Mirador.

DAY 4 – **WED/SAT/MON - (VT) / (TT) **DIVISADERO (COPPER CANYON) to CHIHUAHUA CITY****

After breakfast at Hotel Mirador on the rim leave at 9:00am on a van trip to Chihuahua City. Today a stop to the Mennonite Community before arriving to Chihuahua City is included. Estimated arrival time in Chihuahua City is 2:00pm.
