DAY 1 – TUE/THUR/ SUN - (VT) / (TT) CHIHUAHUA CITY, CHIHUAHUA

Upon arriving at Chihuahua City Airport (CUU), a van and driver will meet you right outside the airport for a ride to the hotel. Chihuahua City is the capital of the state of Chihuahua, the largest state in Mexico. This large, clean, high-desert city has museums and art galleries worth visiting. Revolutionary history abounds here. Check into the Quality Inn San Francisco for an overnight stay.

DAY 2 – WED/FRI/MON - (VT) / (TT) CHIHUAHUA CITY, CHIHUAHUA / COPPER CANYON

After breakfast, depart at 8am for Copper Canyon. On the way, pass through the Chihuahuan Desert for a stop in the Mennonite community of Cuauhtémoc. Continue to the Magical Town (Pueblo Mágico) of Creel, located 260 kilometers (160 miles) southwest of Chihuahua. Creel is situated at an altitude of 2,240 meters (7,350 feet), but it is not located on a canyon rim. Stop at Creel's central plaza for lunch and continue to Arereko Lake and the mysterious rock formations, followed by a visit to the old Jesuit Mission of San Ignacio.

Your destination today is the beautiful Mirador Hotel on the rim of the Copper Canyon--the most scenic location in the canyon system. The view alone from your balcony is worth the trip. Check in at Hotel Mirador on the rim for an overnight.

DAY 3 – THUR/SAT/TUE - (VT) / (TT) COPPER CANYON RIM

After breakfast at Hotel Mirador, experience cultural interaction with the Tarahumara and take advantage of numerous opportunities to continue exploring the canyon and enjoying the gorgeous views, as well as special events at Hotel Mirador.

DAY 4 – FRI/SUN/WED- (VT) / (TT) COPPER CANYON, CHIHUAHUA / CEROCAHUI

Breakfast at Hotel Mirador. Check out Hotel Mirador and gather at the hotel lobby at 12:30pm for departure to Cerocahui, a favored destination for those seeking extraordinary natural beauty. Travel 60 minutes through a thousand landscapes of spectacular green carpet scenery.

Check in at picturesque Hotel Mision in time for lunch. Relax in the restful Spanish courtyard as gold dome of the nearby 1556 mission church reflects the lively vineyard. Overnight Hotel Mision.

DAY 6 - SUN/TUE/FRI - (VT) / (TT)**CEROCAHUI, CHIHUAHUA / EL FUERTE, SINALOA**

After breakfast at Hotel Mision, depart at 10:15am for a 25-minute van ride to Bahuichivo Train Station. Board the El Chepe train and journey through the Sierra Madre Mountains, descending from over 5,000 ft to almost sea level. Travel through most of the 86 tunnels and 39 bridges of the route.

TRAIN SCHEDULE: Depart Bahuichivo Train Station at 11:25am. Arrive at El Fuerte Train Station at 2:35pm. Travelers will disembark at El Fuerte Train Station for an afternoon in El Fuerte. Stroll the historic plaza only one block from Hotel Posada Hidalgo. Overnight Hotel Posada Hidalgo.

DAY 7 - MON/WED/SAT - (VT) / (TT)**EL FUERTE, SINALOA / LOS MOCHIS AIRPORT (LMM)**

Ninety-minute transfer from El Fuerte to Los Mochis. Allow three hours for international check in process.
