

**COPPER CANYON, CLASSIC PACKAGE #6 2026**  
**CHIHUAHUA CITY - EL FUERTE / LOS MOCHIS**  
**Arrive Chihuahua City: Monday, Wednesday & Friday**  
**06 DAY /05 NIGHT**

**DAY 1 - MON/WED/FRI - (VT) / (TT) CHIHUAHUA CITY, CHIHUAHUA**

Upon arriving at Chihuahua City Airport (CUU), a driver will meet you right outside the airport for a transfer to your hotel. Explore on your own Chihuahua City and environs.

**DAY 2 - TUE/THU/SAT - (VT) / (TT) CHIHUAHUA CITY to DIVISADERO (COPPER CANYON), CHIHUAHUA**

After breakfast, check out and gather at the hotel lobby at 8:00am for a van ride to Divisadero. En route, included is a stop at a Mennonite community (*closed on Sundays*). Continue travel and take a short break to visit the magical town of Creel. Creel is at an altitude of 7,820 feet, but not on a canyon rim. In Creel visit the main plaza, Arareko Lake and the mysterious rock formations of the Valley of Mushrooms followed by a visit to the old Jesuit Mission San Ignacio and interact with the Tarahumara natives in their cave home.

You are scheduled to arrive at the beautiful Mirador Hotel at 5:00pm. You are right on the rim of Copper Canyon – the most scenic location in all the canyon system. The view alone from your balcony will be worth the whole trip to you. This hotel has a wonderful, relaxing atmosphere and it is very conducive to contemplating the natural wonders around you.

**DAY 3 - WED/FRI/SUN - (VT) / (TT) DIVISADERO (COPPER CANYON)**

Breakfast at Hotel Mirador. There are many activities available through the hotel concierge. The most recommended tour is to Divisadero Overlook and Barrancas del Cobre (Copper Canyon) Adventure Park (included). The Park is in the heart of the Sierra Tarahumara. It has the third longest cable car line in the world, and activities for the whole family, a restaurant with glass walls and floor to continue your enjoyment of the spectacular views. There is also hiking, biking and horseback riding. Another feature is the zip lines, which claim to be some of the longest in the world. There are hanging bridges, rock climbing with anchor points, and a world of adventure sports for all ages. Overnight Hotel Mirador

**DAY 4 - THU/SAT/MON - (VT) / (TT) DIVISADERO (COPPER CANYON) to CEROCAHUI, CHIHUAHUA**

Breakfast at Hotel Mirador. There are many activities available through the hotel concierge this morning. The most recommended tour is to Divisadero Overlook and Barrancas del Cobre (Copper Canyon) Adventure Park. Check out at 11:30am and take an hour van transport to the beautiful valley of Cerocahui to picturesque Hotel Mison. Relax in the restful Spanish courtyard and admire the gold dome of the nearby 1556 mission church. You have time this afternoon to wander into the churchyard or stroll through the village to the cemetery and lumberyard or visit the Tarahumara boarding school, next door to the hotel, a 4-mile roundtrip walk to the Cerocahui waterfall or a highly recommended optional tour to Urique Canyon Overlook (3pm); the deepest canyon overlooks in the system for some of the most expansive canyon views on this trip. Overnight Hotel Mison.

**DAY 5 – FRI/SUN/TUE– (VT) / (TT)****CEROCAHUI, CHIHUAHUA to EL FUERTE, SINALOA**

Breakfast at Hotel Mision. Check out and gather at the lobby at 9:30am for a 35-minute van ride to Bahuichivo Train Station. All aboard the Chihuahua al Pacifico train on a 4½ hour ride through the Copper Canyon on the famous El Chepe. Journey the Sierra Madre Mountains descending over 5,500 ft to sea level as you travel some of the 86 tunnels and 39 bridges of the route to El Fuerte.

**TRAIN SCHEDULE:** Depart Bahuichivo Train Station at 11:25am. Arrive El Fuerte Train Station at 2:35pm. Travelers will disembark at El Fuerte Train Station for an afternoon in El Fuerte. Stroll the historic plaza one block from Hotel Posada Hidalgo.

**DAY 6 – SAT/MON/WED– (VT) / (TT)****EL FUERTE, SINALOA to LOS MOCHIS, SINALOA**

Breakfast at Hotel Posada Hidalgo. Transfer to Los Mochis (90 min van ride). **Drop off locations limited to:** Los Mochis Airport (LMM), Los Mochis Bus Terminal, Topolobampo Bay (Baja Ferry) or Hotel Santa Anita.
